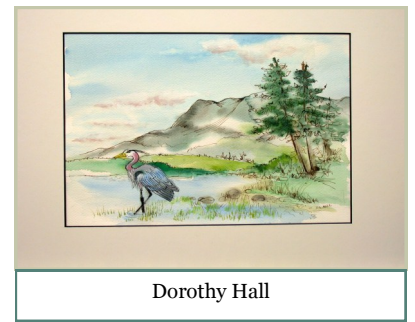

Sept 13 **Iris Van Rynbach** ***Children's Book Illustrator***

Iris Van Rynbach studied at the Pratt Institute and Parsons School of Design in New York City and the Ecole des Beaux Arts in Paris. I allow my ideas to unfold and reveal themselves. I work in oil pastels, collage elements, and acrylic medium. Roberta will demonstrate a simple abstract and guide us through thinking about the many components involved. Abstracts are more involved than many realize and demonstrate the basics of good art—design, feeling, composition.
